One can wonder how Luke's Gospel passage today might have been different if Mary, not Martha, had been the one to complain to Jesus, if Mary had said "Lord, look at her! Here you are sharing your wisdom and all she can think about is supper." Jesus may have noted, as Luke does, that Martha was burdened with much serving. Later in his writings, this same evangelist will describe in Acts how the early community set aside people whose ministry it is to see to the serving at table.

As a fully human person, Jesus knew the human needs that had to be tended. He doesn't deny this, nor does He chastise Martha for her working in service. He chides her for being anxious and worried. How can Martha—or any of us—be anxious or worried about the serving that needs to be done when we do it in the context of the Lord's will and wisdom?

The Church has done more than any other institution to bear the heavy burdens of serving the ill, the uneducated, the suffering; has been "Martha" to countless of the little ones whom Christ told us were His very presence. **HOSPITALITY MINISTERS:** Most parishes and liturgical communities have hospitality ministers – whether they are called that or greeters or ushers or some combination of all these.

Hospitality at church is far more than a pleasant greeting and welcome (although surely these are important aspects of the ministry). Hospitality ministers must understand themselves first of all as disciples and, like Mary in the gospel, must assume in their lives and ministry a listening stance toward Jesus. The ministry points to Christ's presence in the community, emphasizes all are welcome

because all are members of the Body of Christ and helps the assembling church members prepare to listen to Jesus speak to their hearts during the liturgy. Hospitality ministry is more than a practical convenience or a social nicety; it is an expression of Jesus' ministry that recognizes the other's dignity as members of the Body of Christ.

**July 22 Mary Magdalene Feast day**

Mary Magdalene, in spite of the undeservedly tarnished reputation she held for 15 centuries, is arguably the second most important woman in the New Testament. She is mentioned a total of 14 times in all four accounts of the Gospel, more than most of the apostles.

Mary Magdalene was one of the followers of Jesus and one of the few witnesses of His crucifixion and burial. At dawn on the third day, she went to anoint the body and was the first to see the empty tomb.
