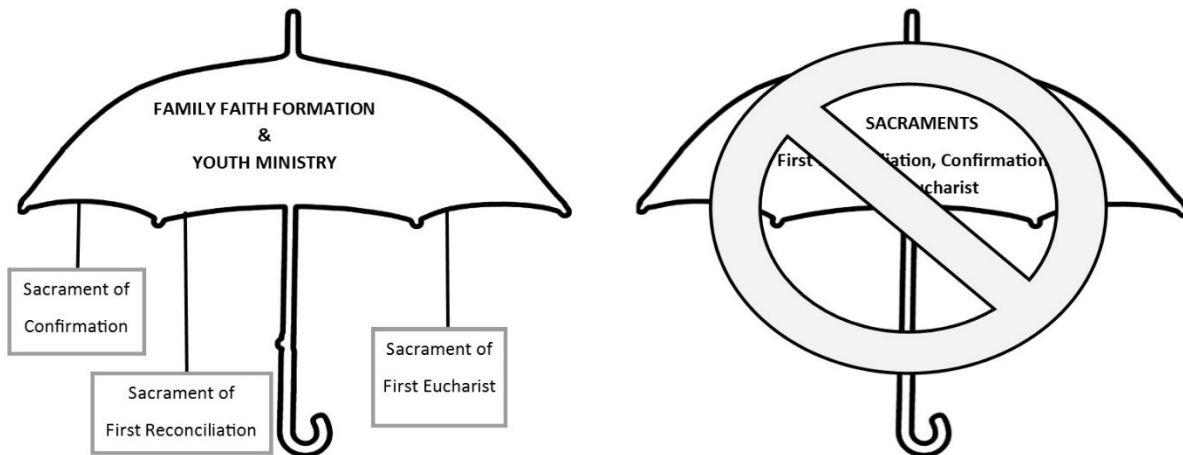

## Registration Notification

When registering your child he/she is placed into an age appropriate grade level for Family Faith Formation (formerly known as Religious Education) for grades Pre-Kindergarten to 8<sup>th</sup> and Youth Ministry for grades 9<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup>. (see umbrella illustration on the left).

After completion of one full year in the Family Faith Formation and Youth Ministry, baptized children who are in the second grade or older who have been properly catechized may start the preparation process for the Sacrament of First Reconciliation, Confirmation and First Eucharist (Communion) in that Original Order.



For many parishes, the only Family Faith Formation or Youth Ministry was a Sacrament preparation program (illustration on the right). Once it ended, the unintended message often was, “You have completed the process, received the sacraments and have all the formation you need in your faith.” Yet we know that our formation in the faith and commitment to it is a life-long journey. Therefore, we highly encourage parents to register their child in our program every year after they receive the sacraments.

Jesus instituted and entrusted the Church to give us grace and make us holy. The sacraments are visible signs of what takes place spiritually in our lives to strengthen, nourish and heal us. Our goal is to keep young people welcomed, engaged, active in the Church and stronger in their catholic faith so that they may seek to fulfill our parish mission “Rooted in Jesus~We Love and Serve Others”.
