We thank each one of catechists and their families for their support, sacrifice, prayer and love.

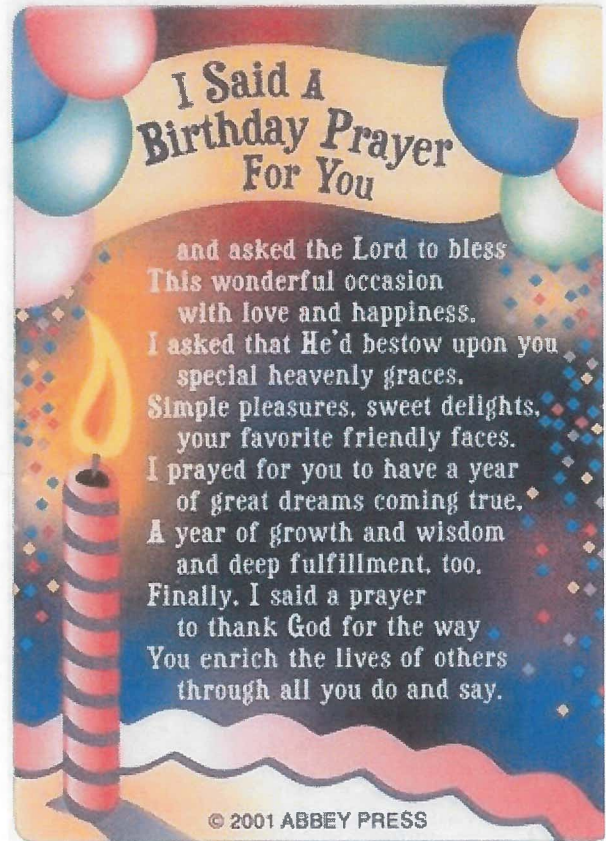
